



#### 2025 AEF SCHOLARSHIPS

The American Experience Foundation (AEF) enriches the lives of students and young people through inspirational travel experiences and educational opportunities to cultivate the next generation of hospitality industry professionals. AEF is the 501(c)(3) non-profit affiliated with Destination DC, Washington DC's official destination marketing organization.

AEF invests in young people through:

- ★ Free field trips to the nation's capital for students from DC and across the country
- ★ Internships and educational opportunities to connect students with industry professionals
- **★** Scholarships to qualified students and alumni

Only students enrolled in or have graduated from one of the Academies of Hospitality & Tourism, Culinary Arts, & Mass Media at the following schools in Washington, DC are eligible to apply. Alumni of the now closed Hospitality High School are also eligible to apply.

- 1. Ballou High School
- 2. Columbia Heights Educational Campus
- 3. Coolidge High School
- 4. Jackson-Reed High School

- 5. Maya Angelou Public Charter High School
- 6. River Terrace Education Campus
- 7. Roosevelt High School

**Each scholarship is \$2,500.** Awards are based upon a solid academic background, work and/or internship experience, and interest in a career in hospitality, culinary arts, or media. Additional scholarships or honorariums of various amounts may also be awarded.

If awarded to an underclass student, funds will be held by AEF and then transferred to the student or to their higher education institution upon graduation from high school. Students are responsible for contacting AEF with this information.

The scholarships are intended to cover such items as tuition, education materials, and fees. Higher education institution can be any post-secondary educational experience, such as a professional certificate or training program, two- or four-year degree program, or graduate program.

Students are encouraged to reapply annually. Scholarships are not automatically renewed.

#### There are 3 types of scholarships available.

Each scholarship uses the same application. There is no need to submit more than one application. All applicants will be automatically considered for Distinguished Scholarships if they are qualified.

### 1. AEF Scholarships

AEF offers scholarships to Academy of Hospitality & Tourism, Culinary Arts, & Mass Media students at the above seven high schools in Washington, DC. Typically, one scholarship is awarded per school; additional scholarships may be awarded to qualified applicants.

### 2. Alumni Scholarship

Available to qualified alumna or alumnus of the above Academies currently enrolled or looking to enroll in an institution of higher education or training program. Awards are based upon a solid academic or work background and interest in a career in hospitality. At least one Alumni scholarship will be awarded annually; additional scholarships may be awarded.

### 3. <u>Distinguished Scholarships</u>

These qualities should be documented in the applicant's resume, essay and/or letters of recommendation. Community should be defined by the applicant in their application and may include the student's school, work, neighborhood, place of worship, or other community or group.

- **★ The David Iselin Memorial Scholarship** recognizes a student from any of the eligible Academies who has an exemplary dedication to <u>community service</u>.
- **★ The Ray Bennett Memorial Scholarship** recognizes a student from any of the eligible Academies who has demonstrated exemplary leadership qualities in their community.
- **★ The Akira Wilson Memorial Scholarship** recognizes a student at **Jackson-Reed High School** who has demonstrated exemplary <u>leadership</u> and <u>entrepreneurship</u>.
- ★ The Joe Shymanski Memorial Scholarship recognizes a student in the Mass Media Academies with a demonstrated interest in commercial media, photography, videography or graphic design.

## **All AEF Scholarships Include**

### Scholarship

\$2,500 payable to either the student or the student's higher education institution. The student may decide how they would like to receive the funds. If money is given directly to the student, it will be disbursed in two installments of \$1,250 each, one per semester.

#### **Events**

Scholarship winners will be invited to American Experience Foundation and Destination DC events, including the Awards Ceremony & July 4<sup>th</sup> VIP Celebration. These events offer excellent opportunities for winners to connect with Washington DC's hospitality industry professionals and each other. Winners are encouraged, but not required to attend.

### May 22, 2025 Awards Ceremony & Reception, 4-7 p.m.




## 1. Go to https://bit.ly/aef scholarships


10. At any time in the application, you may scroll to **the very bottom of the application page** to save your application.




To return to your application, log into the scholarship portal at using the email and password your submitted in Steps 3 and 5. You can reset your password as needed on the login page.


- 11. Type your full name in the first box.
- 12. If you are under 18 years of age, please provide the name and contact information of your parent or legal guardian.




13. Fill out information about your Academy. You can select as many Academy Pathways or Academy Requirements as apply to you.



14. Please tell AEF about yourself and your post-secondary training plans.




15. Complete this section ONLY if you are already enrolled in college, university, or a post-secondary training program.



16. Your essay can either be typed in the box OR you can upload your essay.



17. Your recommendation letters will need to be filled out online by the person that is recommending you.


To send them an email asking to upload your recommendation letters, please use the following example email.

Enter your recommender's email in the box and click "Compose Email."




18. An email box will pop up where you can send a personalized email to your recommender, asking them to write you a recommendation letter. They will ALSO receive a separate email with instructions on how to upload their letter for you.


Please be sure to tell your recommender ahead of time about writing you this letter and have a conversation with them to confirm they have received both emails.



# 19. Repeat Steps 15 and 16 for your second recommendation letter.




# 20. Upload your resume.



21. You have two options to submit your transcript.

If you have graduated high school OR if you are a high school student who has a copy of your transcript, you may upload it using the button.

If you are currently a high school student and do not have a copy of your transcript, you can click "Please request my transcript from my Academy Director." AEF will request this transcript on your behalf. Only *current* high school students may use this option.



22. If you are a photography, A/V, graphic design, or other mass media student or alumni who would like to be considered for the Joe Shymanski Memorial Scholarship, please provide a link to a photo, video or graphic design portfolio including at least 3 and no more than 10 work samples.

We recommend using a hosting site like <u>Google Drive</u>, <u>OneDrive</u>, or <u>Box</u> to host your portfolio. Please ensure any links are accessible to anyone with the link. Dead or inaccessible links will not be able to be judged.
